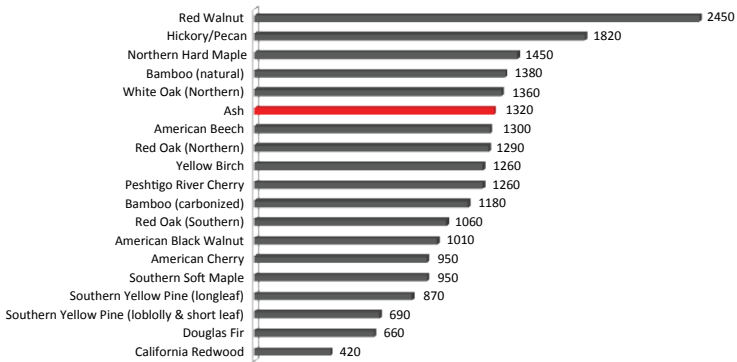
Northern Ash

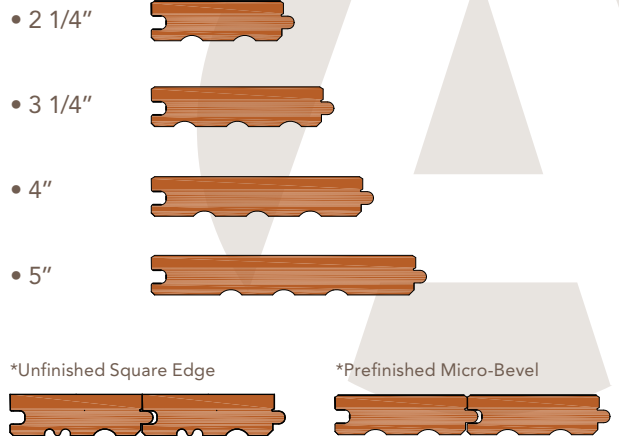

FEATURES AND BENEFITS



SELECT & BETTER
Allows color variation between the very white sapwood and darker heartwood. Allows only pin knots and very minimal mineral streaking. **Average board length is 39"**.



GLACIER
Character Grade flooring with a long average length. All character flaws and imperfections are permitted. This flooring will have extensive color variation. Pencil width knots are allowed to go all the way through the board. **Average board length is 48"**.

- Stained, select grade Ash is an acceptable substitute for Oak.
- Similar to Hickory in character and offers greater stability.
- Ideal for residential and commercial applications.
- Sapwood is creamy white
- Similar in appearance to White Oak only with more color.
- Above average stability.

Aacer Flooring warrants that the products have been manufactured in compliance with the grading rules of Aacer Flooring, and will be free from manufacturing defects, which are limited to improper milling or improper drying only. Manufacturing defects do not include natural wood characteristics such as mineral streaks, knots, grain variations, and normal minor differences between color samples and the color of installed floors. These are normal characteristics and are not defects.
